

Summary of policy and requirement changes that take effect Summer 2024 – Summary for Academic Advisors

Policy/Requirement	Implementation	Change summary	Notes
Academic Standing (COLL-UG 1092)	Universal (all requirement terms)	Brings College into compliance with new campus policy BL-ACA-H8 . Adopts Academic Watch and Academic Alert for what was previously Academic Probation (roughly corresponding to what was Regular and Elevated/Dean's Probation), setting the criteria for each. Adopts new standard for Academic Dismissal, notably requiring the student's most recent standing to be Academic Alert to qualify for automatic dismissal consideration (as one of the prongs). Adopts "reinstatement" as the language for what was previously "readmission." Adds summer as a review term for Academic Standing. Adopts "academic term" in lieu of "semester." Indicates that enrollment at any IU campus will factor into Academic Standing.	Replaces and consolidates COLL-UG 1028, COLL-UG 1029, COLL-UG 1030, and COLL-UG 1031.
College Entrance Requirements (COLL-UG 1093)	Universal	Assigned a policy ID. Removed English Composition, credit hour minimum, College GPA, and Major GPA as requirements for entering the College. Specifies special procedures for students pursuing second degrees and those dismissed from other units. All students entering the College will be assigned an academic standing based on the COLL-UG 1092 for their most recent term of enrollment.	None.
Change of Degree or Major within the College (COLL-UG 1023)	Universal	This policy is rescinded. Students may now change majors within the College without restriction unless: the major requires special admissions (they will need to be admitted to it first); special admission to a major has been revoked; or they are not allowed to change major as a condition of enrollment (Academic Retention Committee decision).	None.
Pass Fail Option (COLL-UG 1008)	Universal	Removed the provision that required students to be in Good Academic Standing to utilize the option.	None.
Executive Dean's List (COLL-UG 1016)	Universal	Clarified that students must be in Good Academic Standing (as opposed to "not on academic probation"). Adopts "academic term" in lieu of "semester." Changed order of criteria for better logical flow.	None.
Grade Point Averages (COLL-UG 1013)	Universal	Removed reference to specific subjects that are considered as not carrying degree credit. Added definition of Academic Term GPA. Clarified how courses X'd through the Extended-X policy or removed via the campus Fresh Start policy are treated in the GPAs.	At some point in the near future, we will create a course list in the <i>Bulletin</i> that shows all the No Degree Credit courses (an Advanced feature option).

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Multiple Withdrawals from All Subjects (COLL-UG 1045)	Universal	Removed language about probation being a possibility for Multi-WAS students. That determination is not made retroactively.	None.
Exceptions to Academic Requirements, Policies, and Procedures (COLL-UG 1049)	Universal	Updated title to include “procedures.” Revised language to direct students to first consult with their College academic advisor. Revised language also establishes procedure for appealing exceptions and sets time limits. These changes, in part, formalize some long-standing practices.	None.
Extended-X (COLL-UG 1009)	Universal	Clarified the date by which Extended-X petitions must be filed by the student.	None.
CASE Sustainability Literacy	Summer 2024 and later matriculants	All students must complete at least one (1) course at IUB designated CASE Sustainability Literacy (CASE SL).	None.
