

Membership Requirements

To maintain membership in the Hutton Honors College, students must complete **two** approved Hutton or departmental honors courses by the end of their **sixth** semester and maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.40 or higher.

Hutton Honors College Scholarship recipients must complete **three** honors courses by the end of their **fourth** semester and maintain the 3.40 CGPA in order to be eligible to renew the scholarship.

Graduating with Honors

<u>The Hutton Honors Notation</u> is recorded on the diploma and transcript and signifies outstanding performance in a broad range of courses.

Notation Requirements:

- 18 hours of honors credit, including 2 Hutton seminars at 3 credits each
- Engaged learning component
- Maintain a minimum 3.40 GPA in the notation courses and a minimum 3.40 CGPA at graduation
- No grade may be lower than a C in the honors courses

Issuing permissions for honors courses

The following courses require permission from the HHC to enroll:

- ARTH-A 102 Renaissance Through Modern Art discussion section 8388
- BIOL-L 112 Foundations of Biology: Biological Mechanisms discussion section 9359
- COLL-C 103 Humor and Wit in the Italian Renaissance discussion section 13461
- GNDR-G 105 Sex, Gender and the Body discussion section 32131

Tips for advising first-year honors students

- Encourage students to take an honors course in the Fall
- Look for honors courses in the student's major or that fill GenEd and CASE requirements. For example:
 - A student in the School of Education could take EDUC-H 205 for honors
 - A student could fill their GenEd A&H requirement by taking HON-H 233
- Encourage students to take an HON-H course, but note that seats may be limited
